The NSC is a highly respected volunteer chorus, committed to excellence in choral performance. Once again the NSC is hosting the Summer Sing series which promotes audience participation in singing some of the world's most beautiful choral compositions. This summer's series is being held select Monday nights during the months of June, July and August at First Church of Christ, Scientist 115 Concord Street, Nashua. The series kicks off June 16th with Mozart's Requiem Mass in D minor (K. 626) conducted by Diane Cushing, Director of the Nashua Symphony Chorus. Other dates with works are:

June 30th, Broadway Favorites, conducted by Jennifer Erdody, Director of Souhegan Chorus with accompanist Kim Whitehead.

July 14th, Rutter Requiem, conducted by Carlos Martinez, Music Director of the Lakes Region Opera, with accompanist Judy Haywood.

July 28th, Mozart's *Regina Coeli* (K. 276) and Vivaldi's *Gloria in D* (choral movements only) conducted by Scott Lounsbury, Director Sunbrook Valley Chorale, with accompanist Calvin Herst.

August 11th, Carl Orff's *Carmina Burana*, conducted by Paul Madore, Director Paul Madore Chorale, with accompanist Minako Merritt.

August 25th, Schubert's Mass in G conducted by Josh Nannestad, Director First Parish Westwood, United Church, with accompanist Humphreville.

The Summer Sings are held from 7:00 PM -9:00 PM with a \$7 fee at door. Music scores are provided, but singers are encouraged to bring their own scores if they have them.
